CRACKING THE MARZANO CODE – MEMBERS ONLY

Questions about the evaluation system? Cracking the Marzano Code is a systems approach to a universal understanding of Marzano and your evaluation. Come learn about the evaluation system and what administrators are looking for when they walk in your classroom. This course is 3 hours long & is not eligible for component points.

CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE PEDAGOGY (PART 1)

Raise awareness about culture in the classroom and strengths-based teaching. This research-based course delves into the beliefs of school culture and those of different ethnic groups. Learn how constraints in the learning environment unintentionally can limit learning and the role of the educator. (3 component points; PLN Course #: 26800; Section name including “Part 1”. Fee for non-members: \$30 or a signed membership form.)

CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE PEDAGOGY (PART 2)

Building on knowledge about strengths-based teaching and why culture matters in the classroom, participants will learn about instructional considerations they can take into account when planning lessons. There will be time to plan culturally relevant lessons and share with other educators. (3 component points; PLN Course #: 26800; Section name including “Part 2”. Fee for non-members: \$30 or a signed membership form.)

ESOL APPLIED LINGUISTICS

This face-to-face class is the same that the district offers and counts towards ESOL certification. It is a 4 session course for 30 face to face hours (7.5 hours with a 30 min lunch). There will be homework & reading assignments. (60 ESOL component points; PLN Course #:19833. Fee for non-members: \$150 or a signed membership form.)

CPR

Upon successful completion participants will be certified. The training is certified by the American Safety and Health Institute. Participants will be required to pass a number of skills tests during the course to receive and maintain their certification. (8 component points; PLN Course #: 26945. There is a \$10 materials fee for members and a \$50 fee for non-members. The fee will be reduced to \$10 with a signed membership form.)

ESOL ESSENTIALS

This face-to-face class is a research-based course from AFT that counts towards ESOL certification. It is a 4 session course for 30 face to face hours (7.5 hours with a 30 min lunch). There will be homework and reading assignments. (60 ESOL component points; PLN Course #:19832. Fee for non-members: \$150 or a signed membership form.)

GENERAL KNOWLEDGE PREP

This study session includes help with preparing for the FTCE General Knowledge Math, Reading, and Essay portions. The first 1.5 hours will be math focused and the second 1.5 hours will be ELA focused. (This course is 3 hours long and is not eligible for component points. Free for members and non-members.)

ESE: MANAGING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOR

The anti-social actions of a small but powerful number of students in school not only put their own academic success at risk, but threaten the learning environment for everyone. This course presents research on emotional and behavioral problems of students who consistently act out. We will learn strategies to reduce and/or prevent the occurrence of disruptive or dangerous outbreaks. This course is 3 sessions for a total of 18 hours face to face & 2 hours of assignments. (20 ESE Component points; PLN Course #:25951) (Fee for non-members: \$100 or a signed membership form.)

SSS: USING QUESTIONING TO THINK AND LEARN

This research-based course examines question types and structures that educators ask in the classroom to assist students in thinking and learning in the classroom. (3 component points; PLN Course #: 27758) (Fee for non-members: \$30 or a signed membership form.)

Professional development classes are free for members (unless otherwise noted). Non-members can attend courses (unless otherwise noted) for a fee or with a signed membership form.
